I, ALAN WILLIAM HEBER PERCY of Old Ferry House Chelsea Embankment, S.W.3. in the County of London Esquire solemnly and sincerely declare as follows:-

1. I am a member of the Percy family and am sixty-six years of age and am a Trustee of the Settled estate of the said family including the Advowson of Airmyrn aforesaid, having been appointed as such Trustee on the Thirty-first day of December One thousand nine hundred and twenty seven.
2. The Advowson of Airmyrn aforesaid is and has been for many years past in the possession of the Percy family.
3. I have inspected the certified copies of the extracts from the Institution Act books of the Diocese of York and the Diocese of Sheffield dated respectively the ninth and tenth days of November One thousand nine hundred and thirty one now produced and shown to me and marked "A.W.H.P.1" and "A.W.H.P.2." respectively and I say that the Right Honourable George, Earl of Beverley, therein mentioned as Patron of the said benefice on the Fourteenth day of August One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine was a member of the Percy family. The several other persons referred to in the said extracts as having exercised the other than Nicholas Edmund Yarburgh and Yarburgh Yarburgh right of patronage to the said benefice were all members of the Percy family
4. Speaking to the best of my knowledge information and belief as to all presentations to the said benefice of Airmyrn made prior to the first day of January One thousand

nine hundred and five and speaking from my personal knowledge as to all presentations made after that date I say that the right of the said several Patrons to present to the said benefice has never been questioned disputed or objected to in any way.

I am able to swear to the facts hereinbefore deposed to from my inspections of the documents and records of the Percy family in my possession as such Trustee and otherwise and from my knowledge of the traditions of the said family and from my personal knowledge and information and I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Statutory Declarations Act 1935.
