SCHEDULE

PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners this 21st day of March 2000 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983, the Right Reverend Graham, Bishop of Norwich, having consented thereto.

Union of parishes

1. The parish of Buckenham with Hassingham and the parish of Strumpshaw, being two of the parishes which comprise the area of the benefice of Burlingham Saint Edmund with Lingwood, Strumpshaw with Hassingham and Buckenham in the diocese of Norwich, shall be united to create a new parish which shall be named "The Parish of Strumpshaw and Hassingham with Buckenham".

Parish churches

2. The church of Saint Mary, being the parish church of the parish of Buckenham with Hassingham, and the church of Saint Peter, being the parish church of the parish of Strumpshaw, shall both be parish churches of the new parish.

Archdeaconry and deanery

3. The new parish shall belong to the archdeaconry of Norfolk and the deanery of Blofield.

Coming into operation of this Scheme

4. This Scheme shall come into operation upon such day after the date of any Order of Her Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme as the Bishop shall direct in writing by an instrument under his hand deposited in the Diocesan Registry.
