## SCHEDULE

### PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners this 9th day of May 1984 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983, the Right Reverend John, Bishop of Salisbury, having consented thereto.

#### **Declaration of redundancy**

1. (1) The church of Manningford Abbots (otherwise known as Manningford Abbas), being a chapel of ease in the parish of Manningford Bruce and Abbots in the diocese of Salisbury, shall be declared redundant by this Scheme.

(2) The marriage register books (if any) appertaining to the said church shall be dealt with in accordance with section 62 of the Marriage Act 1949 and, subject to any provisions of the Parochial Registers and Records Measure 1978 that apply thereto and any directions thereunder, any other register books and records of that church which remain in parochial custody shall be dealt with as the Bishop shall direct.

#### **Coming into operation of this Scheme**

2. This Scheme shall come into operation upon the first day of the month following the date of any Order of Her Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme.
