## SCHEDULE

### PASTORAL SCHEME

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the Commissioners") this 8th day of March 1990 in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983, the Right Reverend Michael, Bishop of Truro, having consented thereto.

#### WHEREAS

1. by virtue of a Scheme (hereinafter referred to as "the 1982 Scheme") made by the Commissioners, in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1968 on the 20th day of May 1982 and confirmed by an Order of Her Majesty in Council on the 23rd day of June 1982, a team ministry was established for the area of the new benefice of Liskeard with Saint Keyne, Saint Pinnock, and Morval in the diocese of Truro;
2. by virtue of an Order (hereinafter referred to as "the 1987 Order") made by the Right Reverend Peter, lately Bishop of Truro, in pursuance of the Pastoral Measure 1983 on the 20th day of September 1987, the number of team vicars in the said team ministry was increased from one to two;
3. the said Right Reverend Michael, Bishop of Truro, has submitted proposals to the Commissioners for, inter alia, the enlargement of the said team ministry by the addition of the parish of Bradoc;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby provided as follows:-

#### **Dissolution of benefice**

1. The benefice of Boconnoc with Bradoc shall hereby be dissolved.

#### **Creation of new benefice of Boconnoc**

2. (1) A new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Boconnoc" shall be created in the diocese of Truro, and the area of the new benefice shall comprise the parish of Boconnoc.

(2) The new benefice and its constituent parish shall belong to the archdeaconry of Bodmin and the deanery of Trigg Minor and Bodmin.

(3) The patronage of the new benefice shall be vested in John Desmond Grenville Fortescue, a Captain (retired) in Her Majesty's Army, of The Stewardry, Boconnoc, Lostwithiel, Cornwall, PL22 0RG.

### **Transfer of parish and alteration of benefice name**

3. (1) The parish of Bradoc shall be transferred to the benefice of Liskeard with Saint Keyne, Saint Pinnock, and Morval in the diocese of Truro.

(2) The name of the benefice of Liskeard with Saint Keyne, Saint Pinnock, and Morval shall be altered to "The Benefice of Liskeard, Saint Keyne, Saint Pinnock, Morval and Bradoc".

### **Amendment of 1982 Team Ministry**

4. Clause 3 of the 1982 Scheme (as amended by the 1987 Order) shall be deleted and the following shall be substituted:-

#### **"Establishment of team ministry**

3. (1) A team ministry shall be established for the area of the new benefice.

(2) The cure of souls in that area shall be shared by the incumbent of the new benefice, whose office shall be that of rector in the team ministry, and two other ministers, each of whom shall have the title of vicar and a status equal to that of an incumbent of a benefice.

(3) That area shall be in the pastoral care of those who are to share the cure of souls therein together with all other persons who are from time to time authorised by licence or permission of the Bishop to serve in that area as members of the team."

5. The Schedule to the 1982 Scheme shall be amended as follows:-

(a) sub-clause (1)(a) shall be deleted and the following sub-clause shall be substituted:

"(a) the Bishop, who shall be chairman of the Board and shall have one vote as a member of the Board and a casting vote as chairman;"

(b) the following additional clause shall be inserted:

"(2) John Desmond Grenville Fortescue, a Captain (retired) in Her Majesty's Army, of The Stewardry, Boconnoc, Lostwithiel, Cornwall, PL22 0RG, who shall have one vote;"

(c) clause (2) shall be re-numbered (3) accordingly.

## **Union of benefices**

6. The benefice of Lostwithiel, the benefice of Saint Winnow, the benefice of Saint Veep and the new benefice of Boconnoc created pursuant to clause 2 hereof, all in the diocese of Truro, shall be united to create a new benefice which shall be named "The Benefice of Lostwithiel, Saint Winnow with Saint Nectan's Chapel, Saint Veep and Boconnoc", and the area of the new benefice shall comprise the parish of Lostwithiel, the parish of Saint Winnow, the parish of Saint Veep and the parish of Boconnoc, which parishes shall continue distinct.

## **Archdeaconry and deanery**

7. The new benefice and its constituent parishes shall belong to the archdeaconry of Bodmin and the deanery of Trigg Minor and Bodmin.

## **Designation of first incumbent**

8. If immediately before this Scheme comes into operation the Reverend Alexander Edwin Allardice is licensed by the Bishop to serve within the area of any of the benefices referred to in clause 6 hereof he shall be the first incumbent of the new benefice.

## **Place of residence**

9. Pending the provision at Grenville Road, Lostwithiel of a parsonage house for the new benefice, the parsonage house of the benefice of Lostwithiel shall be the place of residence of the incumbent of the new benefice.

## **Disposal of parsonage house**

10. The parsonage house of the benefice of Saint Winnow, together with the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds usually occupied and enjoyed therewith, shall be transferred to the Truro Diocesan Board of Finance for disposal in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 9 of Schedule 3 to the Pastoral Measure 1983.

## **Patronage**

11. Subject to clause 8 hereof, the right of presentation to the new benefice shall on each occasion be exercised jointly by the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Saint Mary in Truro and John Desmond Grenville Fortescue, a Captain (retired) in Her Majesty's Army, of The Stewardry, Boconnoc, Lostwithiel, Cornwall, PL22 0RG.

### **Coming into operation of this Scheme**

12. This Scheme shall come into operation upon the first day of the month following the date of any Order of Her Majesty in Council confirming this Scheme.
